- A copy of your transcript

Students may apply for both universities in one application, indicating their first choice in their letter of motivation.

Please note: Tuition **only** will be covered through the exchange agreements.

Students must make their own payment arrangements for accommodation and any other expenses. Please see the 2023-24 information sheets for UGA and WSU. Please continue to check the host university and LMU International Office websites for updated information.
